

THE NATIONAL CURRICULUM GUIDE IS BASED ON FIVE FUNDAMENTAL PILLARS





- All students have the right to enter secondary school
 - The state is oblished to provide a place for students in secondary school until they are 18 years old
 - The secondary schools are mostly run by the state and all are funded by the state
- Students can apply for the place they want and change if they consider it right each semester
- All academic schools make their own curriculum
- The schools have compulsory subjets, such as Maths, Icelandic language, English, Danish and a third language
- The headmaster chooses his own staff

Education is really important for

society and teachers are highly regarded by society

Government invests all the money that is necessary (17'22% of GDP)

Three classes per day of 40 minutes each one

Students can behave as they want in class. No rules, even legs on the table.

Education is something secondary and teachers are, in general, poorly regarded by the comunnity

Very few resources for public education (1'07 GDP)

Six classes per day one hour long

Lots of rules for behaviour




Differences



• Marks are not so important. All students pass to the next level and they continue their studies at the university or college that they want. Unemployment in Iceland is less than 6%. Each student elaborates their own curriculum (Science - Social or Bacheley for life)


