Visit to top roof of the hotel Room Mate Valeria, situated at Plaza de la Marina. Ideal for a drink or a cup of coffee.

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
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TUESDAY 19th FEBRUARY 2019

10:00 Visit Museo Picasso.

12:00- Visit La Alcazaba (Moorish Castle) We split in 2 groups guided by Zegrí Association.



14:00 Lunch at the centre (on our own). Students may go back home if they wish. Teachers can have lunch at any of the many good restaurants in the area.

16:00- Visit Málaga Cathedral.

Santiago's Parish is an extra good option. Another option is visit Casa Hermandad de Estudiantes / Sepulcro at calle Alcazabilla. Museo de Málaga, next to the Alcazaba is free for European visitors.

Places we shouldn't miss in the area:

Visit the wine cellar “El Pimpi”, just opposite the Roman Theatre. Enter through that door and come out at calle Granada. Ideal place for tapas if we get a chance of a table. It is always packed.

Restaurant “Citron” at Plaza de la Merced.

Restaurant “Palo Cortado” at calle Molina Larios.

Spectacular view of Málaga from the roof top of the hotel Marriot “Málaga Palacio”. You have to pay for a drink at the main hall before using the lift to the 15th floor. 8 Euros approx. (It's worthwhile)

If the weather is nice, “El Balneario” is a beautiful place to watch the sunset. Bus is required. Lines 3 or 11. It is an almost rundown building from the beginning of 20th century where citizens used to go to bathe in the sea.
